



Neighborhoods/Communities of Interest: District 21 links higher-income communities in the southern part of San Mateo County and the northwestern part of Santa Clara County that reside in areas with similar hillside topographical features. The district also links and preserves the integrity of cities in San Mateo and Santa Clara counties that have common ties, such as Stanford, Palo Alto and Menlo Park.

Neighborhoods/Communities of Interest: District 26 is a Section 5 Voting Rights Act required district for Latinos in Merced County. The district also includes communities in Stanislaus County both to ensure that the district complies with Section 5 and also to group similar populations together. Merced County and Stanislaus County have common interests in their agricultural products, processing facilities, and environmental issues along the San Joaquin River. In addition to its substantial Latino population, Merced County also a significant Southeast Asian and Sikh/Punjabi population in Merced, Livingston, Atwater, Delhi, and Winton that is kept intact within this district.



Fresno CA	Eastern, unpopulated portion of Fresno County home to Kings Canyon National Park is split from portions of Fresno County in Assembly Districts 29 and 30 in order to maintain in one district areas in Tulare and Madera counties sharing similar interests in national parks and forests and environmental issues
Tulare CA	Assembly District 32 includes Kings County, which is a Section 5 Voting Rights Act county; Kings County is not large enough to constitute a district; Assembly District 32 includes a portion of Tulare County to reach ideal size and ensure that the district complies with Sections 2 and 5 of the Voting Rights Act; to prevent splits of cities within Tulare County such as Visalia, the remainder of the county is split between Assembly Districts 28 and 33

Neighborhoods/Communities of Interest: District 28 keeps together national parks and forests, including Yosemite National Park, the portion of Inyo National Forest outside of Inyo County, part of Sierra National Forest, Kings Canyon National Park, and part of Sequoia National Park. The portion of Tulare County in this district includes Visalia, the closest major city to Sequoia National Park and known as the gateway of the Central Valley to the Sequoias. The district also includes the entirety of Madera County, known as the gateway of the Central Valley to Yosemite. Proposed Assembly Districts 29 and 30 to the west split the city of Fresno so that Assembly District 30 complies with Section 2 of the Voting Rights Act by keeping together Latino communities both within and outside the city; Assembly Districts 28 and 29 are drawn to avoid splitting the city of Fresno a second time.

Compactness: Population polygon score is less than 0.50. Population concentrated in western part of district and includes large unpopulated rural areas.

Nesting: No Senate district proposed for this area.



Neighborhoods/Communities of Interest: District 29 is drawn as an east Fresno County community of interest that includes all of Clovis and a majority of the city of Fresno.
