Neighborhoods/Communities of Interest: District 64 is a working and middle class district that unifies the Vietnamese American community in Orange County, the nation's largest Vietnamese American community. Westminster, Garden Grove and Stanton share similar social and economic characteristics, including per capita income, rates of limited-English proficiency, and disproportionate numbers of immigrants. The district also includes Fountain Valley, home to many Vietnamese Americans who own businesses in Westminster and Garden Grove, and the western side of Santa Ana, home to many Vietnamese American community institutions. These communities have more in common than they do with beach communities to the west.
